GUITAR HERO CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES:

NOTE : THERE WILL BE NO WARM-UPS ALLOWED PRIOR TO THE CONTEST

1. Scoring will be based on the highest scores as played by contestant.
2. The contest will be held as a SOLO contest, using the newest version of Guitar Hero – on an X-BOX 360. game console, **No playing** on Career mode, changing characters, guitars etc. You may not bring your own equipment or enter any cheat codes.
3. For effectiveness of the contest, the Qualifying round will be limited to 20 entrants. The top 8 players during the qualifying event will be selected for the finals to compete that evening against the qualifiers from the Naches 4th of July Event and the Moxee Hop Festival.
4. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 places in the finals.
5. Contestants must register prior to the event. Onsite registration will begin at 2:30pm and end at 3:30pm on Monday, September 28, 2009 at the CWSF Main Stage. E-Mail and Postal Mail must be received by the evening of September 21, 2009 at 5pm.
6. Guitar Hero has an ESRB rating of “T” for TEEN. Because of this rating, children under the age of 13 will **NOT** be permitted to enter the contest.
7. Qualifying will start at 4pm and run until either 4:30pm or all contestants have played 1 song.
8. Finalists need to be at the stage by 3:30pm to ensure a timely start and to secure your spot that was previous earned. The finals will start at 4:45pm.
9. Contestants for the Qualifying round will play **hard skill mode ONLY!**
10. ALL Finalists, will compete on **expert mode** for the finals. The contestant’s song will be selected at random from the list of songs on the newest version of Guitar Hero in September. In the event of a tie – Guitar Hero 3 will be used and Through the Fire and Flames will be the played by both contestants.
11. No restarts or retry’s (unless directed by the host for technical reasons.)
12. Anyone blatantly damaging any of the equipment will be financially responsible to replace the broken equipment.
13. Anyone found violating these rules will be disqualified.
14. Rules are subject to change/be amended as needed, any amendments to the rules shall be posted at the event.
